

BLACKJACK HANDOUT FOUR

Card Delivery

- ☑ The dealer delivers one card to each player beginning with the first player on the dealers left. The cards should be placed gracefully, face up in front of the players bet between the bet and the dealer.
- ☑ The dealer will always place the second and subsequent cards in such a manner that the center pips are visible at all times.
- ☑ The dealer will require a hand signal for all actions.
- ☑ After the players have made their decision to draw or stand, the dealer exposes the hidden card. This card is on the dealer's left and [REDACTED]. The dealer must draw to a hard 17 or higher.
- ☑ The dealer will check under all Aces and Ten-valued cards to see if he/she has a blackjack. This is accomplished by using the [REDACTED] peek device installed on each game.
- ☑ If the dealer has an Ace up he or she will offer Insurance before peeking.

Regular Payoffs

- ☑ Pay or take third base (the spot farthest to your right) and continue around the table in a counter-clockwise manner.
- ☑ Paying the player in the first base or first spot position may be done with the dealer's left hand.
- ☑ Dealers will always pay next to players bet when converting but NEVER pay behind or cross over to pay.
- ☑ Players may not touch the cards.

Blackjack Payoffs

- ☑ A blackjack is an Ace with any card with a value of ten in the first two cards.
- ☑ The bonus portion of blackjack payoff is stacked next to the original bet and the bottom cheque is exposed.

Blackjack Payoffs 3:2 1 ½ x the bet or bet + ½ the bet.
