

## BLACKJACK HANDOUT TWO

### SEVEN-STEP SINGLE-DECK SHUFFLE (20 seconds)

1. Plug any un-dealt cards into two the discard holder in a random manner.
2. Remove the entire stack from the discard holder and place in the middle of the table.
3. Cut the stack in half.
4. Rotate the right side one half turn.
5. Riffle together, box (transfer 1/3 deck from the bottom to the top), strip, and riffle.
6. Box and riffle.
7. Offer the cards for the cut. Do not take your eyes off the cards during the cut. The guest must cut at least 10 cards from either end.

### TEN-STEP DOUBLE-DECK SHUFFLE (30 seconds)

1. Split any un-dealt cards into two equal stacks and plug the cards in the discard holder in a random manner.
2. Remove the entire stack from the discard holder and place in the middle of the table.
3. Cut the stack in half.
4. Rotate right side one half turn.
5. Take one half from each stack, riffle together, box (transfer 1/3 deck from the bottom to the top), riffle again and place in the center.
6. Repeat step 5 with the remaining cards.
7. Strip (from the top to the bottom in 5 sections) the stack.
8. Take the two decks now in the middle of the table, break in half and riffle together into a single stack.
9. Offer the cards for the cut. Do not take your eyes off the cards during the cut.
10. After the cut, insert the cards into the discard rack and use the notch as a guide to insert the second cut card approximately 26 cards from the bottom.

### EIGHT-STEP 6-DECK SHUFFLE (80 seconds)

1. Split any un-dealt cards into two equal stacks and plug the cards in the discard holder in a random manner.
2. Break shoe into three equal stacks.
3. Take each two-deck stack and complete riffle, box, riffle. (Box 1/3 of cards from bottom, strip 5 sections from top)
4. Take approximately 35 cards off each of the three stacks, complete riffle, strip, riffle and place in one separate stack.
5. Repeat until complete.
6. Roll the stack
7. Offer the cards for the cut. Do not take your eyes off the cards during the cut. The guest must cut at least 52 cards from either end.
8. After the cut, use the notch/line on the side of the shoe as a guide to insert the second cut card approximately 52 cards from the bottom.

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
