

DICE TECHNICAL STANDARDS

✓ DICE

The stick person must watch the dice at all times and is responsible for their security.

✓ CALLING THE DICE

The stick person will make calls in a loud distinct voice and in an enthusiastic manner while selling the proposition bets when appropriate

✓ PAYOFFS / BASE

Cut out all payoffs in the come area before handing off to the player.

✓ CLEARING HANDS

Whenever your hands leave the surface area of the table always clear them with your palms up.

✓ PROPOSITION BETS

Base dealers will not pay off proposition bets until instructed by the stick person. or Box

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
