BANK HAVING 3:

(B) A 2 -- "Players show 3."
"Bank has 3. Card for the players"
(P) K 3 8 "STAND! Bank wins - 3 over 1"

(B) Q 3 5 "Players show 3"
"Bank has 3. Card for the Players"
(P) J 3 9 "Card for the Bank, players at 2"
"Bank wins - 8 over 2"

BANK HAVING 4:

(B) 8 6 -- "Players show 5"
"Bank has 4. Card for the Players"
(P) A 4 A "STAND! Players win - 5 over 4"

(B) 8 6 4 "Players show 5"
"Bank has 4. Card for the Players"
(P) A 4 3 "Card for the Bank, Players are at 8"
"TIE HAND! 8 to 8. Press, change Rearrange. Ties pay 8 to 1"

BANK HAVING 5:

(B) 3 2 2 "Players show 1"
"Bank has 5. Card for the Players"
(P) J A 7 "Card for the Bank, Players are at 8"
"Players win - 8 over 7"

(B) 3 2 2 "Players show 1"
"Bank has 5. Card for the Players"
(P) J A 7 "Card for the Bank, players are at 8"
"Players win - 8 over 7."

BANK HAVING 6:

(B) 8 8 -- "Players show 5"
"Bank has 6. Card for the Players"
(P) K 5 5 "STAND! Bank wins - 6 over nothing"

(B) 8 8 3 "Players show 5"
"Bank has. Card for the Players"
(P) K 5 7 "Card for the Bank, Players are at 2"
"Bank wins - 9 over 2"

BANK HAVING 7:

(B) 4 3 -- "Players show 5"
"Bank has 7 and stands"
(P) K 5 9 "Card for the Players"
"Bank wins - 7 over 4"

PLAYER SHOWING 6:

(B) K 2 8 "Players show 6 and stand"
"Bank has 2. Card for the Bank, Players are at 6"
(P) 9 7 -- "Players win - 6 over nothing"

(B) Q 6 -- "Players show 6 and stand"

"TIE HAND! 6 to 6"

(P) 9 7 -- "Ties pay 8 to 1"

PLAYER SHOWING 7:

(B) A A 7 "Players show 7 and stand"

"Bank has 2 and draws one card"

(P) 8 9 -- "Bank wins - 9 over 7"

(B) 8 8 -- "Players show 7 and stand"

(P) 8 9 -- "Players win - 7 over 6"

PLAYER SHOWING 3:

(B) 2 6 -- "Players show 3"

(P) Q 3 -- "Banks wins - Natural 8 over 3"

PLAYER SHOWING 9:

(B) J 7 -- "Players show a Natural 9 and there will be no draw"

(P) 3 6 -- "Players win - Natural 9 over 7"

PLAYER SHOWING NOTHING:

(B) 5 5 K "Players show nothing"

"Bank has nothing. Card for the Players"

(P) J K 5 "Card for the Bank, the Players are at 5"

"Players win - 5 over nothing"

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
